## INTRODUCTION

We have examined the information referenced by you on the likely performance of your glass brick wall system if it was tested in accordance with AS 1530.4-1997. The information included

## **ANALYSIS**

On 23 October 2000 IBMB conducted a full-scale fire-resistance test on a glass brick wall incorporating 190-mm x 190-mm x 80-mm deep glass bricks with 8-mm wall thicknesses. The bricks were designated as Solaris Glasstein 198 bricks and were laid up in type LM 21 mortar using steel reinforcing bars.

The wall maintained integrity for 64 minutes while the wall was being subjected to the test conditions of DIN 4102 Part 13 which has the same time-temperature and pressure exposure conditions to that of AS 1530.4. Additionally the observations indicate that the integrity determination for this test was equivalent to that of AS 1530.4.

## OPINION/CONCLUSION

Based on the test data detailed above it is the opinion of the Division that your 190-mm x 190-mm x 80-mm (Solaris Glasstein 198) glass bricks wall constructed as specified in IBMB test certificate numbered 3982/6800 –Mp- but excluding the variations listed in section 6, "Annotations" would be capable of achieving fire-resistance levels (FRL) of -/60/- if tested in accordance with AS 1530.4-1997.
